It may be used to call you if school has been cancelled, is dismissing early, is starting late, is having a special event, or wants to remind you about an important day or night. For the school to call you, we must have your correct phone number.

When you are called you will see the district phone number on your caller ID: 501-624-3372. The first couple of words will tell you that this is a message from your child's school.

We will still announce weather cancellations on radio and television broadcasts as we have in the past, but we are excited about this broadcasting system for our parents in the Hot Springs School District.
