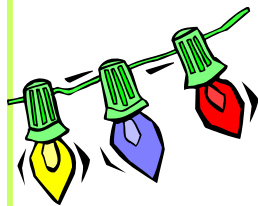

### BEFORE DECKING THE HALLS, THINK GREEN!

As the holiday's approach, think GREEN and switch from incandescent lights to low-energy, longer-lasting LED holiday lights.

The U. S. Department of Energy estimates that if every household made the switch, the country would save almost \$410 million in electricity!

LED's use up to 90% less energy and last up to 40 holiday seasons longer than the regular incandescent lights. LED's also burn cooler and have a nearly un-breakable bulb.
